## WHAT IS A PROFESSIONAL CERTIFICATE IN ACCOUNTANCY?

The IIE Professional Certificate in Accountancy is effectively a bridging programme into the Chartered Accountancy pathway both offered at The IIE MSA. The programme is designed for students who have, for example, completed a non-SAICA-accredited degree or Advanced Diploma, or do not meet the requirements to gain direct entry into the IIE Postgraduate Diploma in Accounting (PGDip Accounting) programme.

The Professional Certificate in Accountancy (PCA) does not lead to a qualification on the NQF and is not accredited by the South African Institute of Chartered Accountants (SAICA) or the CHE of the DHET.

# HOW IS THIS PROFESSIONAL CERTIFICATE IN ACCOUNTANCY STRUCTURED AT THE IIE MSA?

The IIE Professional Certificate in Accountancy is a one-year certificate. The academic year runs from February to November. The modules are delivered on a part-time basis (with lectures and tutorials being scheduled online during the evening from Monday to Thursday).

Please note that in line with academic practice, The IIE's curriculum is reviewed annually and thus changes may occur in module structure and sequence in order to ensure that the programme remains relevant. Registered students receive an updated programme curriculum on an annual basis.
