There are prerequisites for this programme that must be met in order to progress through the qualification.

National Senior Certificate (NSC)

National Senior Certificate (NSC)

English: 50% and Maths/HG: 30% or Math Lit/SG/Technical

Maths: 50%

National Certificate (Vocational) (NC(V))

English: 50% and Maths/HG: 50% or Math Lit/ SG/ Technical

Maths: 60%

Senior Certificate (SC):

Bachelor pass with English: 50% and Maths/HG: 30% or Math Lit/

SG/ Technical Maths: 50%

Senior Certificate (Amended) (SC(a)):

Endorsement with English: 50% and Maths/HG: 30% or Math Lit/

SG/ Technical Maths: 50%

A cognate Higher Certificate or cognate 240 credit Diploma or an Advanced Certificate or 360 credit Diploma may satisfy the minimum admission requirements to degree studies.

If discipline not cognate at least 20% of credits must be academic literacy or numeracy related.
