## Eligibility Criteria for Postgraduate Research Funding for MPhil IWM Students

- 1. Postgraduate research funding will be awarded to students having appropriate qualifications in water and other related fields such as environment and engineering with:
  - a minimum average of 65% for each subject at an honours level at NQF 8
    OR
  - a minimum average of 65% for each subject of a postgraduate diploma at NQF 8

OR

- a minimum average of 65% for <u>all</u> final year subjects of a four-year degree at NQF 8
- 2. Postgraduate research funding will be awarded to South African citizens and permanent residents only.
- 3. Successful applicants will be expected to publish in collaboration with their supervisors with A-listed accredited journals or book chapters.
  - The manuscript does not need to have been published at the time of graduation but should have been accepted for publication or be under review.
  - Ownership of Intellectual Property of the publication shall remain vested in The IIE.
- 4. The postgraduate research funding, awarded to successful applicants will be strictly used for research purposes. This is associated with but not limited to the following:
  - Transport, meals and accommodation
  - Lab experiments and materials
  - Language translation services
